The penny was one of the first coins the U.S. Mint made after its establishment in 1792. The original version of the coin was larger and made of pure copper. Over time, the penny's value has declined relative to its production cost.

On February 9, 2025, President Donald Trump directed the U.S. Treasury to stop minting the penny. On November 12, 2025, U.S. Treasury Secretary Scott Bessent and U.S. Treasurer Brandon Beach announced the last penny would be minted.

## Pasta Fazoolander Soup

This soup recipe is the answer to anyone claiming they don't have enough time to cook after a long day at work. This entire recipe takes about 30 minutes from start to finish. It's the kind of dish you really want to savor on a chilly winter day.



Prep Time: 10 mins \* Cook Time: 20 mins \* Total Time: 30 mins \* Servings: 4

### INGREDIENTS

- |  |  |

| • 1 1/2 tablespoons olive oil                      | • 1 pinch red pepper flakes, plus more for garnish |
| • 1 teaspoon tomato paste                          | • 1 pinch dried oregano                            |
| • 1 anchovy fillet, chopped                        | • salt and ground black pepper to taste            |
| • 4 cups chicken broth                             | • 2 cups baby spinach leaves                       |
| • 1 cup dry cheese tortellini                      | • 1/4 cup grated Parmesan cheese                   |
| • 1 (15 ounce) can white beans, rinsed and drained |  |

### DIRECTIONS

1. \*Heat oil in a large saucepan over medium heat. Stir in tomato paste and anchovy fillet; cook until fragrant and the color deepens, 2 to 3 minutes.
2. \*Pour in chicken broth and bring to a boil. Stir in tortellini and beans; cook until tortellini are cooked through but still firm to the bite, about 10 minutes.
3. \*Stir in red pepper flakes, oregano, salt, and pepper. Add spinach; cook and stir until just wilted, 2 to 3 minutes. Remove from the heat.
4. \*Ladle into bowls and garnish with red pepper flakes and grated Parmesan cheese. Enjoy!

## NEW YEAR RESOLUTIONS FOR YOUR CAR!

New Year car care resolutions should include sticking to a regular maintenance schedule, checking fluids and tire pressure monthly, and driving safely. Other key resolutions are inspecting brakes and wiper blades, replacing worn filters, and addressing any dashboard warning lights promptly. Here's a list of the basics...



### ROUTINE MAINTENANCE

- Follow the maintenance schedule: Adhere to the recommended intervals for oil changes, tire rotations, and other service points in your owner's manual.
- Change oil and filters: Make regular oil changes a priority and resolve to replace engine air and cabin air filters as needed.
- Inspect and replace wipers: Check your wiper blades for wear and replace them if they are cracked or not clearing the windshield effectively.
- Check your brakes: Resolve to get your brake pads and fluid inspected regularly to ensure they are in good working order.

### REGULAR CHECKS

- Monitor tire pressure: Check tire pressure at least once a month and before long trips to ensure proper inflation.
- Check all fluids: Regularly check and top off essential fluids, including engine oil, coolant, transmission fluid, power steering fluid, and windshield washer fluid.
- Listen to your car: Pay attention to any unusual sounds, smells, or vibrations, and don't ignore dashboard warning lights.
