Flats, blow outs, skids and longer stopping distances can all be the result of driving around on underinflated tires. It's hard to tell when a radial tire is underinflated—the tire may not look low until it gets below 20 psi—which is significantly underinflated and unsafe.

Most vehicles today are equipped with a tire pressure monitoring system (TPMS). Race car drivers have been using this technology for years. They

are able to head off dangerous underinflation problems by closely monitoring tire pressure on the track.

STEAK OSCAR

Regardless of who's your favorite Oscar, here's a very rich and absolutely divine dish to enjoy while watching this month's 98th Academy Awards!

Prep Time: 20 mins * Cook Time: 20 mins * Total Time: 40 mins * Servings: 2

INGREDIENTS	
• 2 (7 ounce) beef tenderloin steaks	• 1 pound asparagus, tough ends snapped
• salt and ground black pepper to taste	• 1 packet dry Bearnaise sauce mix
• 1/4 cup butter	• 1 cup whole milk
• 1 (6 ounce) can crab, drained	• 1/2 cup butter

DIRECTIONS

1. Preheat the oven's broiler and set the oven rack about 6 inches from the heat source.
2. Sprinkle the filets with salt and pepper.
3. Melt 1/4 cup of butter in a small saucepan over low heat; gently stir in crab meat and simmer while you broil the beef filets.
4. Broil steaks until they reach the desired stage of doneness; for medium (slightly pink in the center), broil 10 to 12 minutes on the first side and 6 minutes on the second side. Set steaks aside to rest.
5. Place a steamer insert into a skillet, and fill with water to just below the bottom of the steamer. Cover, and bring the water to a boil over high heat. Add asparagus, recover, and steam until just tender, 2 to 6 minutes depending on thickness.
6. Whisk Bearnaise sauce mix with milk in a saucepan. Add 1/2 cup of butter, and bring the sauce to a boil over medium heat, whisking constantly; reduce heat to a simmer, and whisk until sauce has thickened, about 1 minute.
7. To assemble, top each broiled steak filet with crab meat, then half of the asparagus.
8. Spoon Bearnaise sauce to taste over asparagus and serve.

AAA'S 5-POINT CHECKLIST FOR SPRING CAR MAINTENANCE

After a long, cold winter, temperatures are rising and the open road is beckoning. Before you pack the picnic basket and take a drive with the windows down, use this five-point checklist for spring car maintenance to make sure nothing interrupts your day!



1. TEST YOUR CAR BATTERY - Winter's chill makes your battery work harder and saps its strength, shortening its lifespan. Most of the time, there's no warning that your battery is about to die. Since the battery is the life force of your vehicle, when it fails, you're stuck!



2. CHANGE YOUR OIL AND FILTER - Winter weather is hard on your vehicle's oil and filter. Cold temperatures can cause your oil to become thicker and flow slowly, putting a lot of stress on your engine. Once the chill leaves the air, it's the perfect time to schedule an oil change to keep your engine purring like a spring kitten.



3. CHECK YOUR TIRE PRESSURE - Winter weather causes tires to become underinflated, and low tire pressure can be dangerous. As you head into springtime, it's important to check the pressure (PSI) of your tires in the morning before you start your car. Check your owner's manual to make sure the pressure readings match the recommended tire pressure for your vehicle.



4. REFILL YOUR TRANSMISSION FLUID - Winter wreaks havoc on your car's transmission, which can lead to very costly repairs. If it gets too cold, the parts contract, causing damage and leaking of transmission fluid. Plus, the fluid can thicken in chilly weather, reducing its ability to lubricate interior parts, causing further damage. In spring, check the transmission fluid level and refill if needed.



5. REPLACE YOUR WINDSHIELD WIPER BLADES - Frosty temperatures, ice, and snow damage wiper blades making them warp, bend, crack, and tear. Be sure to replace this important safety component in spring to ensure you can see clearly.
