

December was originally the 10th month of the year gets its name from the Latin tenth. When the Romans lded January and February to the calendar, it became the 12th month.

MAKE SURE YOU CAN GO IN THE SNOW!

Heavy snow can be fun for some, but many drivers dread treacherous winter driving conditions.

"Many drivers overlook auto care this time of year, even with inclement weather in the forecast," says Rich White, Executive Director of the non-profit Car Care Council. "Driving in snow, especially in heavy snowfall or a blizzard, takes patience and preparation. A vehicle that is properly prepared for the elements can help you avoid an unplanned road emergency when the weather takes an unexpected turn for the worse."

To ensure that your vehicle is ready for winter, the Car Care Council recommends that motorists perform a winter maintenance check of areas that have direct impact on winter driving.

- 1. Battery Cold weather is hard on batteries, so it's wise to check the battery and charging system for optimum performance. Batteries don't always give warning signs before they fail, so replace batteries that are more than 3 years old.
- 2. Antifreeze Antifreeze (coolant) should be flushed and refilled at least every two years in most vehicles.
- 3. Brakes Have the brake system checked. Brakes are critical to vehicle safety and particularly important when driving on icy or snow-covered roads.
- 4. Tires Check the tire tread depth and tire pressure, including the spare. If snow and ice are a problem in your area, consider special tires designed to grip slick roads.
- 5. Oil Be diligent about changing the oil at recommended intervals and check the fuel, air and transmission filters at the same time.
- 6. Lights and Wipers Make sure all exterior and interior lights are working so you can see and be seen. Check the fluid level in the windshield washer reservoir and replace wiper blades that are torn, cracked or don't properly clean your windshield.

In addition, the council recommends a thorough Vehicle Inspection by a trusted professional service technician as winter magnifies existing problems such as pings, hard starts, sluggish performance and rough idling.



DEC 16TH, 1773 - BOSTON TEA PARTY

The Boston Tea Party was a political protest that occurred on December 16, 1773, at Griffin's Wharf in Boston.

American colonists, frustrated and angry at Britain for imposing "taxation without representation," dumped 342 chests of tea imported by the British East India Company into the harbor. The event was the first major act of defiance to show Great Britain that Americans wouldn't take tyranny sitting down, and it served to rally American patriots across the 13 colonies to fight for independence.



DEC 21ST - WINTER SOLSTICE

The word solstice comes from the Latin "sol" (sun) and "sistere" (to stand still). The day of the winter solstice is the shortest day of the year, meaning the one in which we experience the least amount of daylight in 24 hours. In the Northern Hemisphere, as summer advances to winter, the point on the horizon where the Sun rises and sets advances southward each day.

The high point in the Sun's daily path across the sky, which occurs at noon, also moves southward each day. At the winter solstice, the Sun's path has reached its southernmost position. The next day, the path will advance northward. However, a few days before and after the winter solstice, the change is so slight that the Sun's path seems to stay the same, or stand still.






In traditional festive lore, Santa Claus's reindeer pull a sleigh through the night sky to help Santa deliver gifts to children on Christmas Eve. Santa's sleigh is led by eight reindeer... Dasher, Dancer, Prancer, Vixen, Comet, Cupid, Dunder and Blixem. They are based on names used in the 1823 poem "A Visit from St. Nicholas" (commonly called "The Night Before Christmas") by Clement Clarke Moore, arguably the basis of the reindeers' popularity.

In the original version, Moore used the Dutch spelling for the reindeers' names. In "An American Anthology, 1787–1900", Edmund Clarence Stedman reprints the poem using German spellings, and Dunder and Blixem become the now more popular Donner and Blitzen (or "Thunder and Lightning" in English).

The enduring popularity of the Christmas song "Rudolph the Red-Nosed Reindeer" has led to Rudolph often joining the list, bringing the number of Santa's reindeer up to nine!
