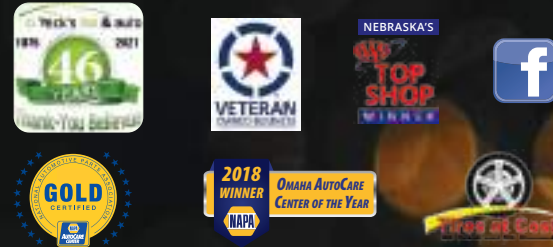

## THERE'S NO NEED TO 'WARM UP' MODERN VEHICLES IN COLD WEATHER...

It's that time of year when many motorists wonder if they need to let their vehicle "warm up" or idle before driving. In fact, today's modern cars are ready to drive in cold temperatures without excessive idling, says the non-profit Car Care Council. The idea of idling before driving dates back to when cars were built with carburetors. With new fuel-injection technology, complex computer systems & thinner synthetic oils, drivers don't need to warm up their cars before hitting the road.

According to the Environmental Protection Agency, "When a car idles for more than 30 seconds, it has several negative effects, such as increasing air pollution unnecessarily, wasting fuel & money, and causing excessive wear or even damaging a car's engine components, including cylinders, spark plugs & the exhaust system. Contrary to popular belief, idling isn't an effective way to warm up most car engines."

"Unless you are trying to defrost the windshield or warm the interior of your car, idling is not required for today's vehicles," says Rich White, Executive Director, Car Care Council. "The best way to warm up your car's engine is to drive gently at the start. Remember, a vehicle gets zero miles per gallon when idling & the result is lower fuel economy & wasted money."

Marvin C. Stone patented the modern drinking straw, made of paper, on January 3, 1888, to address the shortcomings of the rye grass straw which was in use at the time. He came upon the idea while drinking a mint julep on a hot day in Washington, D.C.

The taste of the rye was mixing with the drink and giving it a grassy taste, which he found unsatisfactory, so he wound paper around a pencil to make a thin tube, slid out the pencil from one end, and applied glue between the strips. He later refined it by building a machine that would coat the outside of the paper with wax to hold it together, so the glue wouldn't dissolve in the bourbon!

### Cheddar Cheese Soup!

**Ingredients**

- 4 tablespoons salted butter
- ½ cup sifted unbleached all-purpose flour
- 2 cups milk, heated
- 2 cups half-and-half or reduced-fat chicken broth, heated
- 1½ cups sharp cheddar cheese, diced
- ½ teaspoon dry mustard
- ¼ teaspoon each salt & ground black pepper
- Crumbled bacon or chopped hard-boiled egg for garnish (optional)

**Directions**

- 1.) MELT butter in a large saucepan over medium-low heat. Gradually stir in flour, making smooth paste. Cook, stirring, for about 5 minutes.
- 2.) WHISK in hot milk, cream or chicken broth & mustard; continue stirring until soup thickens and comes to a simmer. Remove from heat & add cheese. Stir just until cheese is melted.
- 3.) SEASON with salt & pepper. Served topped with crumbled bacon or chopped egg if desired.
