






PRESIDENTS' DAY...FEBRUARY 15TH!

The story of Presidents' Day begins in 1800. Following the death of George Washington in 1799, his February 22nd birthday became a perennial day of remembrance. While Washington's Birthday was an unofficial observance for most of the 1800s, it was not until the late 1870s that it became a federal holiday.

The shift from Washington's Birthday to Presidents' Day began in the late 1960's, when Congress proposed a measure known as the Uniform Monday Holiday Act. This law sought to shift the celebration of several federal holidays from specific dates to a



create more 3-day weekends for the nation's workers, and it was believed that ensuring holidays always fell on the same weekday would reduce employee absenteeism. While some argued that shifting holidays from their original dates would cheapen their meaning, the bill also had widespread support from both the private sector and labor unions and was seen as a surefire way to bolster retail sales.

So, is it "Presidents' Day," or "President's Day," or "Presidents Day?"

Presidents' Day is not actually the name of the official Federal holiday. It is actually Washington's Birthday but most of us call it Presidents' Day or Presidents Day, which can lead to confusion. The good news is all the different versions of spelling Presidents' Day are considered correct by all dictionaries.

"Presidents' Day," in the plural possessive, is the form recommended by The Chicago Manual of Style. Perhaps the most popular form, it indicates a holiday celebrating Washington and at least one other president.

February 2nd Groundhog Day



Groundhog Day is a popular observance in many parts of the United States. Although some states have adopted their own groundhogs, the official groundhog, Punxsutawney Phil, lives at Gobbler's Knob near Punxsutawney, PA.

Tire Rotation & What You Need to Know...

You can make your tires last longer with regular tire rotations. In normal driving, your front tires wear more on the shoulders because they handle much of the cornering forces in

We rotate the tires so that all the tires do some duty on the front end as well as getting a little break on the back end. That way, all 4 tires wear more evenly over their life and last longer.

For most vehicles, tires are rotated front to back. Some manufacturers recommend a cross rotational pattern that includes the spare tire and some high-performance vehicles have different size tires on the front and rear and may even have uni-directional tires that can only be on the left or right side of the vehicle. We can help you sort out and will perform the correct tire rotation for your vehicle.

Tire manufacturers recommend rotating your tires somewhere around 6,000 to 9,000 miles.
