# OCTOBER IS FALL CAR CARE MONTH!

## Motorist Checklist for Fall Car Care Month

The last thing any driver needs is a vehicle that breaks down in cold, harsh winter weather. The non-profit Car Care Council recommends that car owners follow its Fall Car Care Month checklist and inspect their vehicles before the temperatures drop and severe weather hits.

### HEATING, WIPERS & LIGHTS

- ☑ Make sure heaters, defrosters and wipers work properly.
- ☑ Consider winter wiper blades and use cold-weather washer fluid. As a general rule, wiper blades should be replaced every six months.
- ☑ Check to see that all exterior and interior lights work, and headlights are properly aimed.

### TIRES & BRAKES

- ☑ Check the tire tread depth and tire pressure of all tires, including the spare. If snow and ice are a problem in your area, consider special tires designed to grip slick roads.
- ☑ During winter, tire pressure should be checked weekly.
- ☑ Have the brakes checked. The braking system is the vehicle's most important safety item.

### GAS, OIL & FILTERS

- ☑ Keep your gas tank at least half full throughout the cold weather to prevent moisture from forming in gas lines and possibly freezing.
- ☑ Be diligent about changing the oil and filter at recommended intervals. Dirty oil can spell trouble in winter. Consider changing to "winter weight" oil if you live in a cold climate.

- ☑ Check the fuel, air, and transmission filters at the same time.

### SYSTEM CHECKS – CHARGING, COOLING & EXHAUST

- ☑ Have the battery and charging system checked, as cold weather is hard on batteries.
- ☑ Clean, flush, and put new antifreeze in the cooling system. As a rule of thumb, this should be done every two years.
- ☑ Have the exhaust system checked for carbon monoxide leaks, which can be especially dangerous during cold weather driving when windows are closed.

### PACK THE ESSENTIALS

- ☑ Make sure that your ice scraper and snow brush are accessible and ready to use.
- ☑ Stock an emergency kit with jumper cables, a flashlight, blankets, extra clothes, bottled water, nonperishable food and a first aid kit with any needed medication.

## TOTALLY TRIFLING TRIVIA!

**UNDER WHAT NAME WAS OUR BELOVED HALLOWEEN "CANDY CORN" ORIGINALLY MARKETED?**

ANSWER: CHICKEN FEED

Candy corn has been an all-American favorite since the Wunderle Candy Company began making the world's first tricolor candy in the 1880's. Candy corn was first marketed as "Chicken Feed" and the confection proved so popular that the Goelitz Candy Company (they make Jelly Belly's, too!) competed to take over mass-production of the seasonal treat. Having won the rights to produce the candy, the company soon put the original name out to pasture ... and "Candy Corn" was born! Today, the recipe for candy corn is pretty much unchanged from the early days. It's still made from honey, sugar and corn starch. More than 35-million lbs will be produced this year, or about 9-billion pieces!

### ICED PUMPKIN COOKIES

• 2 ½ cups all-purpose flour	• ½ teaspoon ground nutmeg	• ½ cup butter, softened
• 2 teaspoons ground cinnamon	• ½ teaspoon ground cloves	• 1 cup canned pumpkin puree
• 1 teaspoon baking powder	• ½ teaspoon salt	• 1 egg
• 1 teaspoon baking soda	• 1 ½ cups white sugar	• 1 teaspoon vanilla extract

Step 1: Preheat the oven to 350 degrees F (175 degrees C). Grease two cookie sheets.  
 Step 2: Combine flour, cinnamon, baking powder, baking soda, nutmeg, cloves, and salt in a medium bowl.  
 Step 3: Cream together sugar and butter in a mixing bowl until fluffy, 2 to 3 minutes. Add pumpkin, egg, and vanilla; beat until creamy. Mix in flour mixture until combined. Drop tablespoonfuls of dough onto the prepared cookie sheets; flatten slightly.  
 Step 4: Bake in the preheated oven until centers are set, 15 to 20 minutes, switching racks halfway through. Transfer cookies to a wire rack to cool to room temperature, about 30 minutes.  
 Step 5: Meanwhile, to make icing, stir together confectioners' sugar, milk, butter, and vanilla in a bowl until smooth. Add milk as needed, to achieve drizzling consistency.  
 Step 6: Drizzle icing over cooled cookies with a fork.
