HIT A POTHOLE? LOOK FOR THESE WARNING SIGNS...

Potholes occur when water permeates the pavement, usually through a crack, and softens the soil beneath it, creating a depression in the surface of the street. Many potholes appear during winter & spring months because of freeze-thaw cycles, which accelerate the process. Potholes can also be prevalent in areas with excessive rainfall & flooding. Hitting a pothole with your car can do a real number on tires, wheels, steering & suspension, and alignment. The non-profit Car Care Council urges motorists to watch for three warning signs to help determine if hitting a pothole has damaged their vehicle.

- 1. Loss of control, swaying when making routine turns, bottoming out on city streets or bouncing excessively on rough roads are indicators that the steering & suspension may have been damaged. The steering & suspension are key safety-related systems. Together, they largely determine a vehicle's ride & handling.
- 2. Pulling in one direction, instead of maintaining a straight path, and uneven tire wear, are symptoms of an alignment problem. Proper wheel alignment is important for the lifespan of tires & helps ensure safe handling.
- 3. Low tire pressure, bulges or blisters on the sidewalls, or dents in the wheel rim will be visible & should be checked out as soon as possible, as tires are the critical connection between the vehicle & the road.

"If you've hit a pothole, it can be difficult to know if & to what extent your car has been damaged," says Rich White, Executive Director, the Car Care Council. "It's a good idea to describe the symptoms to a professional technician who can then check out the vehicle & make the necessary repairs to ensure safety & reliability."



DID YOU KNOW....

After years of false starts & delays, the Hubble Space Telescope was launched into low-Earth orbit as part of a multi-billion-dollar project led by NASA and the European Space Agency. The bus-sized observatory is equipped with an 8' wide focusing mirror & an array of cameras capable of seeing visible, infrared & ultraviolet light, yet the telescope only takes pictures in shades of black & white. The dazzling snaps of nebulae, supernovae & galaxies captured by Hubble are released after undergoing a postproduction process to add color. Hubble's cameras only take photos as gray-scale pixels, so astronomers make multiple exposures of the same object using different filters – typically red, blue & green - to capture various wavelengths of light These are then overlaid to create a single composite image. Scientists also occasionally insert additional color into the images to bring out details that would otherwise remain invisible to the human eye.

WHAT DOES THE TERM "URL" STAND FOR?

Answer: Uniform Resource Locator

Anyone who works or plays on the internet has seen or heard the term "URL", which stands for "Uniform Resource Locator." It is an identification system used to find a resource on the internet & is what we often call a web address. The URL tells web browsers where & how to retrieve whatever resource a person is looking for. Users enter the URL into a browser by typing it directly into the browser's address bar, or by clicking on a hyperlink. Webpages, bookmark lists, emails & other forms of internet gateways use hyperlinks as a way to point traffic to a particular website.

Easy Pecan Pie

1 teaspoon pure vanilla extract 1 cup light or dark corn syrup 1–1/2 cups (6 ounces) coarsely chopped pecans 1 (9-inch) unbaked or frozen deep-dish pie crust 1 cup granulated sugar 2 tablespoons butter, melted

3 eggs

2. Mix Corn Syrup, eggs, sugar, butter and vanilia using a spoon or a rubber spatula. Stir in pecans and pour 3. Bake on center rack of oven for 60 to 70 minutes. The pie is done when center reaches 200°F. Tap center

surface of pie lightly – it should spring back when done. If pie crust is over-browning, cover edges with foil. 4. If you are using a prepared frozen pie crust, place cookie sheet in oven and preheat oven as directed.

Pour filling into frozen crust and bake on preheated cookie sheet.

5.Cool for at least 2 hours on wire rack before serving.
