"Many people don't realize the consequences of putting off needed vehicle maintenance. Not only can neglecting vehicle service cause safety issues if ignored, but it can lead to costly repairs down the road," states the Car Care Council's board. "With nearly 80 percent of vehicles needing service, a new part and/or repair, chances are your vehicle could use some extra attention."


The Car Care Council recommends following a vehicle service schedule, keeping a free copy of the council's Car Care Guide in the glovebox and performing these most common routine maintenance procedures to keep your vehicle performing at its best...

- Check all fluids, including engine oil, power steering, brake and transmission as well as windshield washer solvent and antifreeze/coolant.
- Check the brake system annually and have the brake linings, rotors and drums inspected at each oil change.
- Check the tires, including tire pressure and tread. Uneven wear indicates a need for wheel alignment. Tires should also be checked for bulges and bald spots.
- •Check the hoses and belts to make sure they are not cracked, brittle, frayed, loose or showing signs of excessive wear.
- •Check the heating, ventilating and air conditioning (HVAC) system as proper heating and cooling performance is critical for interior comfort and safety reasons, such as defrosting.
- •Check the wipers and lighting so that you can see and be seen. Check that all interior and exterior lighting is working properly and replace worn wiper blades so you can see clearly when driving during precipitation.

Be sure to fully inspect your vehicle annually, including performing a tune-up and wheel alignment. If you suspect there is a problem, don't stall and address it quickly before minor repairs become more complicated, expensive repairs. Pi Day is celebrated on March 14th (3.14) around the world. Pi (Greek letter " ω ") is the symbol used in mathematics to represent the ratio of the circumference of a circle to its diameter, a constant which is approximately 3.14159. As an irrational & transcendental number, it will continue infinitely without repetition or pattern. While only 39 digits past the decimal are needed to accurately calculate the spherical volume of our entire universe, Pi has been calculated by mathematicians to over one trillion digits!



RECIPE OF THE MONTH | IRISH SODA BREAD

Irish soda bread made with buttermilk and basic ingredients. The buttermilk gives this crusty loaf a good flavor.It's the best Irish soda bread around AMAZINGLY EASY IRISH SODA BREAD • ½ teaspoon salt 4 cups all-purpose flour Cook Time: 45 mins • 1 cup buttermilk • ½ cup margarine, softened • Total Time:1 hrs 1 egg • 4 tablespoons white sugar Servings: 20 ¼ cup butter, melted • Yield: 1 (1 1/2-pound) loa 1 teaspoon baking soda • 1 tablespoon baking powde

- 2. Mix flour, softened margarine, sugar, baking soda, baking powder, and salt together in a large bowl. Stir in 1 cup of buttermilk and egg. Turn dough out onto a lightly
- 3. Combine melted butter with 1/4 cup buttermilk in a small bowl; brush loaf with this mixture. Use a sharp knife to cut an 'X' into the top of the loaf.
- 4. Bake in preheated oven until a toothpick inserted into the center of the loaf comes out clean, 45 to 50 minutes. Check for doneness after 30 minutes. You may continue to
