## MAINTAIN A HEALTHY WORK-DRIVE BALANCE!

According to the most recent U.S. Census, commutes to work are longer than ever, with the average commute time up 20 percent since the Census began tracking this data in 1980. The more time we spend in our cars, the more important it becomes to make sure our vehicles are comfortable and safe places to be, says the non-profit Car Care Council.

The Car Care Council has a number of tips for commuters to help ensure their trips to and from work are as enjoyable and worry-free as possible.

- Change your cabin air filter. The cabin air filter is responsible for cleaning the air entering the passenger compartment. A functioning cabin air filter will help keep dirt, pollen, dust and exhaust fumes from entering your vehicle's interior. Changing the cabin air filter at recommended intervals will allow you and your passengers to breathe clean air free from allergens and pollutants while commuting to and from work.
- Maintain vehicle safety systems. A vehicle's wipers, mirrors, lights and brakes are key safety features that require routine maintenance. To ensure that you can see and be seen while on the road, make sure all lights are properly functioning, mirrors are clean, and both are properly aligned. Replace wiper blades that are cracked, chattering or streaking in order to maintain a clean windshield. Because driving in stop-and-go traffic is hard on a vehicle's braking system, have your brakes inspected regularly as brakes are your car's most important safety feature.
- A clean car makes a happy driver. The more time spent in the car, the more likely dirt and clutter will collect inside. Maintaining a clean vehicle not only makes for a more comfortable drive, but it also contributes to a vehicle's safety and longevity. Remember to keep the floors free of debris that may obstruct the foot pedals, and wash your car regularly to protect the paint, minimize rust and corrosion, and keep your windows clean for improved visibility.

## RED VELVET CHEESECAKE SWIRL BROWNIES

Ingredients- Red Velvet Brownies		Ingredients- Cheesecake Filling
• 1 cup white sugar	• 1 teaspoon distilled white vinegar	• 1 (8 ounce) package cream cheese at room temperature
• ½ cup unsalted butter, melted	• ¼ teaspoon salt	• ¼ cup white sugar
• ¼ cup unsweetened cocoa powder	• 2 large eggs, slightly beaten	• 1 large egg
• 1 ounce red food coloring	• ¾ cup all-purpose flour	• ¼ teaspoon vanilla extract
• 1 teaspoon vanilla extract		

### Directions

1. Preheat the oven to 350 degrees F (175 degrees C). Grease an 8x8-inch baking pan.
2. For the red velvet brownies: Whisk 1 cup sugar and melted butter in a large mixing bowl; stir in cocoa, red food coloring, 1 teaspoon vanilla extract, vinegar, and salt, one at a time, mixing well after each addition to avoid lumps. Mix in 2 eggs until thoroughly combined.
3. Stir flour into cocoa mixture just until combined; set aside ¼ cup batter. Pour remaining batter into the prepared baking dish.
4. For the cheesecake filling: Beat cream cheese in a bowl using an electric mixer on medium speed until light and fluffy. Add ¼ cup

sugar, 1 egg, and ¼ teaspoon vanilla extract; continue to beat until well blended and only small lumps remain, 3 to 4 minutes.

5. Spoon cream cheese mixture in dollops over the batter in pan; gently smooth tops of dollops even with batter using a knife or offset spatula. Do not over mix. Drizzle reserved ¼ cup of batter over the dollops of cream cheese mixture. Drag a knife or skewer through the batter and cream cheese mixture to create swirls.
6. Bake in the preheated oven until top is dry and edges have started to pull away from the sides of the pan, about 30 to 35 minutes. Cool completely before cutting into bars; store covered in refrigerator.
