MANAGER'S MINUTE

Sometimes finding that weird, intermittent problem can be challenging & often frustrating, to say the least. That is where you can become an Auto Detective! Start with the basics: What, Where and When. You come in and your car is making a funny sound. Where is the sound? Around the right front. What kind of sound? Kind of a clunk, clunk sound. When do you hear it? When I turn & accelerate. Right and left? Forward & back?

You see where I am going – gathering additional information & making notes can give us a logical place to start. You can see how this is much more helpful than just leaving a note that says "making a funny noise".

We need to be able to duplicate the symptoms if possible. Your service advisor needs to know details, like, "It stalls after it's been driven for about 20 minutes & I go over 50 mph." Having all the information so the tech can personally experience the problem will help him test & resolve the issue.

JUNE IS NATIONAL ICED TEA MONTH

- According to the Tea Association of the USA, Americans consume well over 55 billion servings of tea (over 2.5 billion gallons) a year.
- In 1904, New York City tea importer Thomas Sullivan became annoyed at the high cost of the tin boxes he used to send tea samples to his customers, so he switched to less expensive small cloth bags. One of the recipients brewed a pot of tea by simply pouring hot water over the bag... and the rest is history!
- Cookbooks dating from the early 19th century indicate Americans have been drinking iced tea since that time. However, the beverage became generally popular after Richard Blechynden of the India Tea Commission offered free samples to attendees at the 1904 St. Louis World's Fair.
- In 2003, Georgia state representative John Noel tried to pass a house bill making it mandatory for all restaurants to serve sweet tea.
- The teaspoon was developed to easily add sugar to tall glasses full of iced tea.
- Approximately 80 percent of the tea served in the United States today is iced tea.

WHEN DID FATHER'S DAY BECOME AN OFFICIAL U.S. HOLIDAY? **ANSWER: 1910**

Father's Day is an annual holiday honoring people's fathers and celebrating the fatherhood, paternal bonds, and the influence of fathers in society. The nation's first Father's Day was celebrated on June 19, 1910, in the state of Washington. However, it was not until 1972—58 years after President Woodrow Wilson made Mother's Day official—that the day honoring fathers became a nationwide holiday in the United States. Father's Day 2024 will occur on Sunday, June 16.







KENTUCKY GRILLED CHICKEN

Kentucky Fried Chicken? What about Kentucky grilled chicken! The basting sauce is a simple combination of Worcestershire sauce and hot sauce that's the perfect complement to any outdoor summer meal.

• Prep Time: 5 mins + marinating • Grill Time: 40 mins • Servings: 10

Ingredients

- 1 cup cider vinegar
- 4 teaspoons hot pepper sauce
- 2 teaspoons salt • ½ cup canola oil
- 10 hone-in chicken breast • 5 teaspoons Worcestershire halves (10 ounces each) sauce

Directions

- 1. In a bowl or shallow dish, combine the first 5 ingredients. Pour 1 cup marinade into a separate bowl; add chicken and turn to coat.
- Cover and refrigerate for at least 4 hours. Cover and refrigerate the remaining marinade for basting
- 2. Drain and discard marinade from chicken.
- 3. Prepare grill for indirect heat, using a drip pan. Place chicken breasts, bone side down, on oiled rack.
- 4. Grill, covered, over indirect medium heat until a thermometer reads 170°, about 20 minutes on each side, basting occasionally with

WHAT'S THAT SMELL?

Six Vehicle Warning Signs Your Nose Can Recognize! Most vehicles start out with that all too familiar "new car" smell, but there are other vehicle odors that you should learn to recognize, too. Identifying these suspect smells early on can help you be car care aware & avoid the hassle & expense of an unexpected breakdown, says the non-profit Car Care Council.


The Car Care Council recommends a sniff test of your vehicle to identify any unusual smells, including the following 6 warning signs:



- 1. The smell of BURNT RUBBER could be slipping drive belts or misplaced hoses that might be rubbing against rotating drive pulleys. Do not reach in if the engine compartment is hot.
- 2. The smell of HOT OIL could mean that oil is leaking onto the exhaust system. To verify the leak, look for oil on the pavement or smoke coming from the engine area.
- 3. The smell of GASOLINE is likely the sign of a gas leak in some area of the vehicle such as a fuel injector line or the fuel tank. Any smell of fuel can result in a possible fire hazard, so immediate attention should be given.
- 4. The smell of SWEET SYRUP may be a sign that your car is leaking engine coolant from a leaky component related to the car's cooling system. Do not open the radiator cap when it is hot.
- 5. The smell of BURNING CARPET could be a sign of brake trouble and a safety hazard. Have your brakes checked right away, especially if this smell is happening during normal driving conditions.
- 6. The smell of ROTTEN EGGS is never a good one and it could mean a problem with your catalytic converter not converting the hydrogen sulfide in the exhaust to sulfur dioxide properly. This smell can also be attributed to a poor running engine, causing the catalytic converter to become overloaded and fail due to meltdown.

When you smell any peculiar odor, you should not ignore it. Instead bring your vehicle to a professional service technician that you trust to get an informed opinion on the nature of the odor!
