The evidence is clear: tires should have an expiration date. Tire aging is a "hidden hazard" and the useful life of a tire is around 6 years regardless of tread depth. Tires are made mostly of rubber and begin to weaken and fall apart as they age because of oxidation - just like an old rubber band. In 1973, average tread life was approximately 24K miles. Tire tread life has quadrupled in the last 40 years. As tread life becomes less of a factor in the service life of a tire, age/oxidation becomes a more serious concern particularly in hotter climates. If you're not sure how old your tires are, stop by







## Easy OREO Truffles

- 1 (16 oz) package OREO Chocolate Sandwich Cookies, divided
- 1 (8 oz) package Cream Cheese, softened
- Crush 9 of the cookies to fine crumbs in food processor; reserve for later use. (Cookies can also be finely crushed in a resealable plastic bag using a rolling pin.) Crush remaining 36 cookies to fine crumbs; place in medium bowl. Add cream cheese: mix until well blended. Roll cookie mixture into 42 balls
- Dip balls in chocolate: place on wax paper-covered baking sheet. (Any leftover chocolate can be stored at room temperature for another use.) Sprinkle with reserved cookie crumbs
- 3. Refrigerate until firm, about 1 hour. Store leftover truffles, covered, in refrigerator.
