# Mark's Message:

How Do I Know When I Need A Wheel Alignment?

When your wheels are properly aligned, they all (4 wheels) point in the same direction. When they are out of alignment, most people notice a couple of things. First, the car will have a slight or severe pull to one side. If the car has been out of alignment for a while, you'll start to see uneven tire wear.

A whole bunch of steering and suspension components are joined together. Everyday driving can cause your wheels to go out of alignment over time just from the joints loosening up (normal wear & tear). That's why it's important (safety & economically) to have your steering/ suspension components and alignment checked every 1-2 years.

Of course, hitting a pothole or curb can knock a wheel out of alignment or damage a steering or suspension part.

Delaying an alignment can get very expensive because of tire wear: a bad

alignment can chew through a tire quickly! If you see uneven tire wear, if your steering wheel is off center, or if your vehicle pulls to one side ask your Service Advisor about getting an alignment check.

Halloween's origins date back 2,000 years ago in the area that is now Ireland, the United Kingdom and northern France. It originated with the ancient Celtic festival of Samhain, when people would light bonfires and wear costumes to ward off ghosts.

In the eighth century, Pope Gregory III designated November 1 as a time to honor all saints; soon, All Saints Day incorporated some of the traditions of Samhain. The evening before was known as All

Hallows Eve and later Halloween. On the night of October 31 they celebrated Samhain, when it was believed that the ghosts of the dead returned to earth.

Borrowing from Irish and English traditions, Americans began to dress up in costumes and go house to house asking for food or money, a practice that eventually became today's "trick-or-treat" tradition.

In the late 1800s, there was a move in America to mold Halloween into a holiday more about community and neighborly get-togethers than about ghosts, pranks and witchcraft. At the turn of the century, Halloween parties for both children and adults became the most common way to celebrate the day. Parties focused on games, foods of the season and festive costumes.

By the 1920s and 1930s. Halloween had become a secular, but community-centered holiday, with parades and town-wide Halloween parties as the featured entertainment. Despite the best efforts of many schools and communities, vandalism began to plague some celebrations in many communities during this time. By the 1950s, town leaders had successfully limited vandalism and Halloween had evolved into a holiday directed mainly at the young.

Thus a new American tradition was born and it has continued to grow. Today, Americans spend an estimated \$6 billion annually on Halloween making it the country's second largest commercial holiday.

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- 2 (16 ounce) packages fudge stripe cookies
- 1/4 cup honey, or as needed
- 1 (9 ounce) bag milk chocolate candy kisses, unwrapped
